

2023 Street Rehabilitation Project

Construction Update

July 28, 2023

Stinson Boulevard/Pleasant View Drive:

This week, the Contractor completed installation of the new concrete curb & gutter, driveway aprons and pedestrian ramps along the east side of Stinson Boulevard/Pleasant View Drive. All concrete construction items are currently under the 7-day curing period. Vehicle access to driveways and Bronson Drive will be restored on Tuesday, August 1st following the end of the curing period.

Next week, the Contractor will begin final grading and preparation of the base for the new shared-use trail, with paving of the trail anticipated later in the week. Following completion of the trail, the Contractor will shift to rehabilitation of the remaining pavement along the street, beginning with removing the upper two inches of existing pavement. Following milling, the roadway will have a grooved surface, but will remain open and accessible for all traffic. Please note that construction scheduling is tentative, weather-dependent and subject to change.

Cheri Lane – Fillmore Street:

This week, the Contractor completed the removal and replacement of select fire hydrants along Cheri Lane and Fillmore Street.

There is no construction activity anticipated in this project area next week. Additional information on construction scheduling in this area will be provided with future project updates.

South Industrial Center:

Next week, the Contractor is anticipated to begin spot curb & gutter removals in preparation for hydrant replacements along 51st Way and the East River Road East Service Drive.

Street Parking:

In order to provide the Contractor with room to work and prevent any damage to vehicles or personal property, on-street parking in areas of active construction will be restricted, unless otherwise noted, during working hours (7:00 AM – 7:00 PM, Mon-Fri). Vehicles parked within the immediate work area during certain phases of construction may be subject to towing.

Construction

The Contractor's hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. There is potential for occasional work outside of these hours upon City approval.

Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust, mud, and be disruptive to the area. Please be patient with the Contractor and contact us if you have any concerns we can help with.

Resident Access

The City and Contractor will work to minimize inconvenience to residents during construction. Residents can expect to have driveway access during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street. We ask that residents, including children, remain outside the immediate work zone and exercise caution navigating the project area wherever you see workers, equipment, or warning signs.
